

Jaggers opens first Louisville location

Burger concept is from Texas Roadhouse CEO

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Kent Taylor, founder and CEO of Louisville-based Texas Roadhouse, originally launched the burger concept Jaggers in 2014, with its first two locations in Indiana's Noblesville and Indianapolis.

Now, the brand's third location is open right here in Louisville.

The Louisville Jaggers location at 6464 Dutchmans Parkway opened for drive-thru and takeout only Wednesday and hired 70 full- and part-time employees.

"Louisville is our hometown, so we're energized and excited for everyone here to try Jaggers quality chicken sandwiches, better burgers, and fresh salads," managing partner Troy DeVries said in a statement. "For now, we're open for drive-thru and To-

Go, but look forward to welcoming guests in our dining room, as soon as we can."

Jaggers emphasizes fresh ingredients and sells a full menu of sandwiches, chicken tenders and burgers. Some menu items include a spicy crispy chicken sandwich with pepper jack cheese, lettuce, tomato, onion and pickle; and a "Sunrise Burger" with American cheese, ham, fried egg, lettuce, to-

mato, onion and mayo.

There are also grilled chicken salads and a black bean veggie burger on the menu.

Jaggers is open Monday through Saturday from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. and Sunday from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. Guests can also order online at eatjaggers.com.

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
